Welcome Back! This month we will be traveling to the South Pole and the North Pole to learn about penguins and polar bears. We will also be talking about winter birds in our backyards, learning about opposites, what a question is, work on our number books, and learning our house addresses. We will continue to explore the alphabet, talk about the colors black and red, and of course do lots of projects that involve SNOW!!

Alphabet- Starting in January, we will be talking about six or seven letters of the alphabet each month. We will do both the upper and lower case letters, talk about the sound of each letter, what words start with each letter, and begin writing the letters. This will be a very informal presentation of the alphabet. We will also start the alphabet hunt game. The last day of each month, we will send home a brown bag with a special letter inside. Your child should find an item to put in the bag that starts with that letter and bring it to school to show the class the next day.
