Field Trip – Tuesday, October 9, we are off to Homestead Farm. **Please read the attached note for important details about this trip!** This is a fun trip. Each child will go on a hay ride, pick a pumpkin (that they can carry) from the pumpkin patch, take a tour of the farm animals, and sneak a peek at the apple orchard. Our only concern is rain, so please pray for a nice day.
